Jeany Words ... Sin How Jesus "Ups the Ante" on the Law



HOW we approach Scripture is so important.

Not just true because it happened, but also because it happens.

The word translated as "sin" comes from an ancient archery word that describes missing the mark

Matthew 5:17-18 - Jesus is going to give us a "fuller" understanding of law



As a rabbi Jesus is not contradicting or correcting the law... He is contradicting or correcting a way of understanding the law.

If we read the 10 Commandments, the Law, or **Scripture** itself **as** checklist to measure against we miss the point.

> Jesus shifts from "not murder" to "go and be reconciled" because it is all relational.

Jesus is concerned about what is happening on the inside...

Jesus exaggerates / uses hyperbole to communicate how drastic we need to be sometimes to be different.

Matthew 6:22-23 NLT (Jesus says) "Your eye is like a lamp that provides light for your body. When your eye is healthy, your whole body is filled with light. But when your eye is unhealthy, your whole body is filled with darkness. And if the light you think you have is actually darkness, how deep that darkness is!"

Jesus is clear on what constitutes "missing the mark" but we also need to remember how He was with people who the religious people labeled as sinners.

> while He was firm He was also warm, loving, and approachable.

Matthew 4:17 NLT ...Jesus began to preach, "Repent of your sins and turn to God..."

repent: turn and go a different direction



in what ways are you missing the mark? who could you share this with? what will you do differently? who can you forgive?
