Romans 12:10

Be devoted to one another in brotherly love. **Honor one another above yourselves.**

Romans 12:16

Live in harmony with one another. Do not be proud, but be willing to associate with people of low position. Do not be conceited.

Romans 14:13

Therefore let us stop passing judgment on one another. Instead, make up your mind not to put any stumbling block or obstacle in your brother's way.

Romans 15:7

Accept one another, then, just as Christ accepted you, in order to bring praise to God.

Romans 15:14

I myself am convinced, my brothers, that you yourselves are full of goodness, complete in knowledge and competent to **instruct one another.**

Romans 16:16

1 Corinthians 1:10

Ephesians 4:32

Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.

Ephesians 5:19

Speak to one another with psalms, hymns and spiritual songs. Sing and make music in your heart to the Lord,

Ephesians 5:21

Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ.

Colossians 3:13

Bear with each other and **forgive whatever grievances you may have against one another.** Forgive as the Lord forgave you.

Colossians 3:16

Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly as you **teach and admonish one another** with all wisdom...as you sing psalms, hymns & spiritual songs with gratitude in your hearts to God.

1 Thessalonians 5:11

Therefore **encourage one another and build each other up,** just as in fact you are doing.

James 4:11

Brothers, **do not slander one another.** Anyone who speaks against his brother or judges him speaks against the law and judges it. When you judge the law, you are not keeping it, but sitting in judgment on it.

1 Peter 3:8

Finally, all of you, **live in harmony with one another;** be sympathetic, love as brothers, **be compassionate and humble.**

1 Peter 4:9

Offer hospitality to one another without grumbling.

1 Peter 5:5

Young men, in the same way be submissive to those who are older. All of you, **clothe yourselves with humility toward one another,** because, "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble."
