Luke 12:35-47 "Be dressed for service and keep your lamps burning...then you will be ready to open the door and let him in the moment he arrives and knocks..."

vs.42 "A faithful, sensible servant is one to whom the master can give the responsibility of managing his other household servants and feeding them..."

Jesus speaks of coming back to a people who are ready and working, not ready and sitting around.
