

John 4 - story of the woman at the well

**vs.28-29** "the woman left her water jar beside the well and ran back to the village, telling everyone, "Come and see a man who told me everything I ever did! Could he possibly be the Messiah?!"

She leaves the thing and the place that symbolizes the source of her life. **The Jar** was "what she was doing with her time and life" and **the Well** was "where she drew from to sustain her".

Neither were as important as "going to tell everyone"

**vs.39** "Many Samaritan's from the village believed in Jesus because the woman had said..."

# "Transformed people transform cities" - Bill Johnson

**vs. 34** "My nourishment comes from doing the will of my Father who sent me, and from finishing his work."

Too often we strive for fulfillment in the natural things of life but Jesus said true "nourishment" comes from "doing the will of God"

**Romans 12:2** "...then you will learn to know Gods will for you which is good and pleasing and perfect."

**2 Corinthians 5:16-21** "...so we are Christ's ambassadors: God is making his appeal through us. We speak for Christ when we plead, "come back to God"
