the command to Adam becomes a promise to Abraham **Genesis 1:27-28** "... Be fruitful and multiply. Fill the earth..." **Genesis 17:6-7** "I will make you extremely fruitful..."

the promise of getting back on track is made through the promised seed **Genesis 3:15**, **Genesis 13:14-15**, **Galatians 3:16**

The promise finds its fulfillment in Jesus.

But the story of **Abraham**, the story of **Abraham's family** is one of faith followed by doubt & disobedience.

Genesis 15 - God's covenant with Abraham

- God makes a promise with a guarantee
- God speaks in the cultural language of Abraham's day
- Abraham trusts God

And Abram believed the Lord, and the Lord counted him as righteous because of his faith. **Genesis 15:6 NLT**

 better understood as "counted him in right relationship, in covenant relationship"

But the rollercoaster of Abraham's trust and his doubt & disobedience continue...

God is understood by Hagar (**Genesis 16**) as a God who hears, a God who sees us where we are and intervenes on our behalf.

Abraham negotiates with God (**Genesis 18**) revealing something of how God interacts wit his creation.

The son of promise in born and Abraham's trust is tested (**Genesis 21-22**)

- Abraham has messed up so many times, will he finally trust?
- Our God is not like other God's, Our God provides

"Father Abraham had many sons, many sons had Father Abraham..."

Romans 4 - promise comes by right relationship

2 Corinthians 5:14-21 - we are ambassadors of reconciliation
