- In the Garden of Gethsemane the night Jesus was betrayed Mark 14:46-52

Let's talk about Peter

- remember what happened when Peter got scared John 13
- the Angel singles out Peter Mark 16:5-7
- Peter wanted to be a great friend Matthew 26:33-35

Let's talk about Jesus "Now you are my friends..." John 15:9-17

- encouraging one another (Mark & Barnabas)
- defending one another (Barnabas defended Mark)
- picking each other back up (Peter & Mark)
- bringing one another on the journey (Barnabas brought Mark)
- Friends reconcile (Paul & Barnabas)
